#### **STEM Field Trips**

#### 6th Graders Visit the Schiele Museum

The 6<sup>th</sup> grade visited the Schiele Museum on April 11-14. While there, they participated in a roots, stems, and leaves lesson. Students revisited the structure of a plant and the function of each part. Some students were even called on stage to act out each part's function. Groups went on a search outside to identify tree types based on their leaf and trunk characteristics. Students also had a chance to visit the planetarium where they watched a video called, Super Volcanoes, on the humungous screen above their head.
